We hope you are enjoying the Summer so far.

'Parent Engagement' Survey

As a result of our parent engagement survey we have discussed your ideas and how we can move forward on them in the future.

You asked us for more information on your child's learning and progress.

In the past 2 weeks staff have started implementing 'Parent Check-in Chats' in our Under 3s rooms- a quick informal 5 minute catch up with you and your child's keyperson at the beginning or end of day. These are to share information together about what your child is currently interested in and how their skills and learning are progressing both at home and at Nursery. Preschool Parent Check-in-Chats will start in September and will happen approximately half termly (6 weekly). Under 3s will be monthly. We are also planning a date (hopefully around mid-late October) for an Under 2s Parents Evening, where you will receive a written summary of your child's learning and development and have the opportunity to talk to your child's keyperson about this.

You asked for more information -Top Tips such as toilet training, behaviour management strategies and what 'school readiness' is.

We are hoping to plan a Parents' Information evening in the Autumn which will include this information.

For toilet training there is a organisation called ERIC- The Children's Bowel and Bladder Society. The link here is for initial toilet training and how to understand the stages of readiness - <https://eric.org.uk/potty-training/> however they have much more information on their website to support parents top help their children at different stages of toileting/ any issues that may arise.

You showed interest in social events-both family and parent events.

We are looking into the possibilities for suggestions such a quiz night, informal drinks evening as well as a 'picnic in the park' type event.

You showed interest in a 3 hour Parents' First Aid Course.

We are speaking to a First Aid provider about dates. This would be on a first come, first serve basis as numbers would be limited. We will advertise this as soon as we have a date confirmed.



You have shown an interest in our social media and newsletters and the type of information we could include.

We are excited to share that we are launching our new website soon. We are also updating our Social media pages (as you may have already seen). More to follow!

Our newsletter will continue for Nursery-wide information such as upcoming events, reminders etc. We are looking at using Tapestry 'memos' for information on learning ideas, our curriculum and the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) as you requested. This would enable us to make information more age specific for parents. Update news on New Government Scheme- 15 hours funding from 9months old

The government is offering 15 hours funding for working parents of 2 year olds and this will be extended to babies the term after they are 9months, starting from September 2024.

So that we can claim funding on your behalf, all parents who qualify for 15 hours or 30 hours must complete and return a Parent authorisation form no later than 31st August 2024. Hard copies can be found in your child's room or on Reception.

If applying for working parents funding all new claims and codes must be received by 31st August 2024.

Please remember to reconfirm your eligibility for the working parents funding every 3 months, or when requested to do so by HMRC. Failure to reconfirm could result in you falling out of eligibility.

Please visit the HMRC website www.childcarechoices.gov.uk to check your eligibility for September 2024.

Should you qualify please forward your code to Bernie at admin@advantagedaynursery.co.uk so that she can send you the relevant paperwork and adjust your fees accordingly.
